There are lots of fruits mentioned in the Quran including Figs, Pomegranates, Dates and Olives

Work with children to try and learn Surah Teen

FIG

- The Fig is mentioned in Surah Teen
- This surah talks about the creation of people
- Prophet Adam and Bibi Hawwah clothed themselves with the leaves of the fig tree, and therefore the fig tree represents the tree of Prophet Adam
- The fig is mentioned only once in the Holy Quran
- Mention that Allah talks about Mount Sinai in this Surah
- There are many benefits to eating figs. The 8th holy Imaam, Imaam Ridha (a) said to eat figs for:
 - Improving hair growth
 - o Removing bad breath
 - Curing colic and piles
 - o Curing pains, especially joint pains, and strengthening the bones
- The Holy Prophet (saw) said: 'Eat figs! If I could say a certain type of fruit was sent down for us from the heavens, I would say it was the fig because it has no seeds and in it there is a shifa'a (remedy)'

OLIVE

- The Olive is mentioned in Surah Teen
- If you lose something, you should recite surah Teen to find it
- The Olive Tree is said to refer to the time of Prophet Nuh when after the flood, he sent a pigeon to search for signs of land and the pigeon returned with a small branch of the olive tree
- There are many benefits to eating olives. The first holy Imaam,
 Imaam Ali (a) said that people who use olive oil and vinegar will not be afflicted with poverty
- If you apply olive oil to your skin, it can:
 - Delay the effects of ageing
 - Soothe aches and pains
 - Help heal boils, rashes and itching
 - o Moisturise skin and prevents dandruff
 - o Be a remedy for teeth and gum diseases, when applied with salt
- The Holy Prophet (saw) said: 'Use olive oil and anoint yourself with it, because it is from a blessed tree'
