## Children's activities during half term


The children in nursery have been busy having fun and learning through their interest.

#### Attendance

It has been noted a few children are not using their funded sessions. The new guidelines are not as flexible as they use to be. It affects children's progress and following the next steps to their learning. Any long term absences and irregular pattern in absences will be looked into. There is a possibility that the long term absences will have to reimbursed by the parents to cover the funded amount not used. A failure to meet the guidelines would mean giving up your child's place to someone else who is on the waiting list eager to start nursery.
