And [mention, O Muhammad], when Luqman said to his son while he was instructing him, "O my son, do not associate [anything] with Allah . Indeed, association [with him] is great injustice."

- Preamble
 - People search for spirituality, and the real source of spirituality is the teachings of the Ahlul Bayt
 - Examples of these teachings can be found in Sahifa Sajjadiyya and the Treatise of Rights
 - It is imperative not to associate anything with Allah
 - Sincerity can be attained by perfecting the intention
 - One of the greatest Blessings to Luqman was 'hikma' [wisdom]
- Tafsir
 - The Holy Prophet is narrating what Luqman said to his son
 - The phrase 'while he was instructing him' is deliberate
