
How to instil love of Allah in children

 - At every stage God took care of us




- Verse is regulating institution of polygamy
 - Polygamy was rampant already but Islam came to regulate it.
- Context of the verse after battle of Ohad they were many widows. To support them polygamy was allowed.
- The doors of polygamy are open but the keys to this door is in the hands if the woman
 - During nikah the woman's side initiate and man accepts it
 - Man doesn't initiate
 - Even in polygamy the woman initiates
- Further to the context many narrations emphasis on the regulatory aspect of this polygamy:
 - "Any man who marries more than one and doesn't give justice .. he will go to hell"
- Verses need to be looked at holistically
- Islam looks at women individually
- As daughters -
 - how Islam liberated daughters . people used to bury their daughters

- Prophetic narrations on the importance of daughters:
 - "What great gifts are daughters.. They are blessed
 - Prophet when addressing a person who was sad that a daughter was born :
 - Why are you worried the earth will carry her weight, the sky will shade her, Allah will provide for her, she will be a flower that gives out a beautiful smell
 - "There is no parent who gives birth to 3 daughters or raises 3 daughters and he is good to them, Allah creates a barrier between that person and hell
 - In another hadith jannah is wajib for such a person
 - "...One who raises them well until they get married or even if they pass away, then I and this person will be so close in heaven just like to these 2 fingers (and he pointed to his index and middle finger, bringing them close to each other
 - Someone asked what about 2 daughters he said even for 2 is the same
 - What about 1 even for 1 is the same
 - Imam Baqir:
 - Whoever brings joy to the heart of his daughter is like freeing a slave from the children of prophet Ismail
