- Human beings are naturally disposed to making sense of the world around them. Why? How? What are the implications?
- Common analogy in Islam is this world is like a Journey, summed up by Quranic Verse Inalilahi wa inailahi raajeoon
- Verse 86:6 Kadhan emphasis its difficult
- In any journey we need three things Where we are, where we are going and road that connects one to the other
- Signs in Sura Rum Plotting out the road. 30:19-26
- Are these signs allowing me to traverse the path (i.e. get closer to God)??
- However within all these signs there are requirements Signs for those who think, those who hear, those who listen, those who use reason.
- If I were to ask myself what am I doing right now we would say sitting, talking, moving but we miss out breathing, blinking etc. Why? Because they are so obvious.
- Similarly we can miss some of the signs and the manifestations of God since they are so obvious.

Summary (1 sentence):

We are on a journey towards God. He has placed on this road many signs however sometimes we miss them because they are so obvious. We must open our eyes towards this signs and thus brighten the path towards Him.
